**Nashua, NH** – Great American Downtown announces the following street closures for their upcoming event, the 2011 Winter Holiday Stroll in downtown Nashua, NH, on Saturday, November 26 from 5 – 10 p.m.

Cars must be moved off of Main Street at 3 p.m. in preparation for the complete street closures at 4 p.m.

- Main Street between West Hollis and Canal Streets, 4 p.m.
- Eldridge Street between Main and Spring Streets, 4 p.m.
- West Pearl Street, 4 p.m.
- East Pearl Street between Main and Spring Streets, 4 p.m.
- High Street between Main and School Streets, 9 a.m. *\*High Street Garage will be accessible throughout entire event by approaching it from the west end*
- Factory Street between Main and Walnut Streets, 4 p.m.
- Water Street, 4 p.m.
- Temple Street between Main and Spring Streets, 4 p.m.
- Court Street, 4 p.m.
- Park Street, 4 p.m.
- Pearson Avenue, 4 p.m.
- Railroad Square, 4 p.m.

These streets closures will remain in effect until at least 11:15 p.m. to allow for sweeping and cleaning.

- Holman Stadium with continuous Shuttle Service starting at 4 p.m. dropping off at Library Hill (ADA compliant busses)
- Rivier College with continuous Shuttle Service starting at 4 p.m. dropping off Hollis Streets
- Elm Street Parking Garage

- High Street Parking Garage (accessible from westbound direction and via Factory Street)
- Southern NH Medical Center Parking Garage
- Street parking in spaces that are not located on the streets mentioned above
