Thank you for your interest in becoming a Dirty Girl CSA member. By joining our CSA you are receiving the benefits of local, organically grown produce. By establishing a relationship with your farmer, you are eating with integrity and creating a more resilient local food system. Becoming a CSA member means you will experience first hand what it's like to eat seasonally and fresh. Enjoy the benefits of healthy, fresh produce grown just for you!

2017 CSA shares are utilized like credit. This makes it easy for customers to split a CSA share with a friend or family member, and allows more flexibility and convenience for both parties. Purchasing a CSA share gives you 10% more value!

Runs from mid June - end of October

Large Share \$600 (\$660 value) - This is designed for a family of 4 or 5 individuals.

Medium Share \$500 (\$550 value) - This is designed for a small family of 2-3 individuals.

Small Share \$400 (\$440 value) - This is designed for a single person household, or a family of 2.

Half Share \$200 (\$220 value) - This is designed for an individual who is curious about a CSA share, but may not eat many vegetables.

CSA Agreement:

I hereby purchase a Dirty Girl CSA membership for the 2017 season.

Community Supported Agriculture is a relationship beyond a simple exchange of organic produce for cash. It is based on mutual respect between CSA members and the farmer. It is very important that members be mindful of the following:

- A) I rely on income from the CSA to operate the farm.
- B) I plant and tend crops for months before the member sees them at market. Each CSA share represents the work and attention to detail that goes in to seeding, transplanting, weeding, growing and harvesting your vegetables.

It is my responsibility to grow nutrient dense vegetables for my members. It is the members responsibility to pick up their share on the appointed dates and times.

Members acknowledge that although I am committed to growing high quality produce in accordance with organic standards, there are risks involved in the nature of agriculture (drought, disease, unpredictable weather, early frosts, rodents, crop failure). Risks are shared between farmer and member. I will do my best to provide a high quality bounty each and every week.

Members may cancel their share by June 1st for partial refund. Full refunds are not available, as I rely on CSA money to purchase seeds, greenhouse operation cost, and tools prior to market season.
